



Membership Categories:

Full Privilege Member Privileges

Each Full Privilege Membership in the Club is a Family Membership, which provides full privileges for immediate family members. Immediate family members will include Member's spouse and unmarried children of either spouse under the age of 23 living at home, attending school full-time or serving in the military. Club Members are also entitled to invite extended family members to enjoy the Club facilities at reduced guest fees. Extended family members will include parents, grandchildren and children who are 23 or older. These individuals may use the Club in the company of the Member.

Full Privilege Membership

Access to all SBCC facilities including golf course, dining, swimming pool, and tennis courts.

- No green fees. Pays 100% of the applicable cart or trail fee
- Family privileges
- Complete calendar of Club social events
- All members are Family Memberships
- Guests will be welcomed when accompanied by a Member
- Club Committees allow Members to help tailor the Club to fit the Members' needs.
- Gourmet dining may be enjoyed in the exquisite dining room
- Casual dining will be available poolside and in grill room
- Members enjoy charging privileges in the dining rooms throughout the Club and pro shop.
- Use of the driving range no charge for range balls

Junior Full Privilege Membership

Members enjoy the same privileges as Full Privilege Membership listed above. Age 19-36 based on head of household.

Non-Resident Full Privilege Membership (Out of County)

Non-Resident Golf Membership has the same privileges as a Full Privilege Member, but must have principal residences located outside Scotts Bluff County.

Individual Golf Membership Privileges

An Individual Membership of SBCC provides you unlimited use of the golf course, driving range and dining facility. This membership provides your spouse and all dependents under the age of 23 living at home the enjoyment of unlimited use of the dining facility accompanied by the member. Your privileges also include all social events and "Member" parties. Additional limited golf privileges may be purchased for your family on an individual guest fee basis (3 visits per person per year). Tee-times can be made up to one week in advance. This does not include use of the swimming pool or other facilities for you or your family.

Individual Golf Membership- continued

Access to golf course and dining facilities only.

One Time Existing Full Privilege Member opportunity

Any existing members that are currently "FULL" privilege members that are interested in changing to this new individual membership classifications are only eligible after successfully referring a new Member at the same level for one for the following classifications:

Individual Membership

Individual Membership - Junior

Full Privilege

Full Privilege – Junior

Existing members that are social or dining will be allowed to move to this new classification without any additional obligations.

There will be a threshold (100 total). The Board of Directors will have the right to evaluate and change the threshold for the individual membership.

We will allow members to commit to the individual level but discounts won't go into effect until the new member joins with them. Grandchild Membership

The Grandchild Membership allows Full Privilege Members the ability to purchase a month-by-month full privilege membership for a grandchild. The Grandchild Membership is available to grandchildren under the age of 18.

Eligible up to the level of membership and the rights of that level of membership. Example: A social membership cannot purchase a golf privilege pass or a dining member cannot purchase a pool pass.

These rules subject to interpretation by the Board of Directors or Management.

Corporate/Business Full Privilege/Social Members

Corporate membership

Initiation fee of \$5000 which allows up to 5 corporate members will be charged to the corporation up front. For each additional golfing member an additional \$1000 initiation fee will be added or \$500 for each additional social member. The initiation fee will include a corporate stock purchase with one vote.

If members leaves the corporation and wishes to stay a member of SBCC, there's no waiting period as with other members.

These rules are subject to Board of Directors interpretation and modification.

Dues for the next 5 years will be discounted 20%.

- It must be a legally formed business entity (corporation, P.A., L.L.C., etc) that was not specifically formed to apply for a Business Membership.
- Applicable monthly dues will be charged to each designee, current food minimums will be assigned to each designee and each designee must pay applicable assessments authorized by the Board and/or membership.
- The corporation receives a 20% discount on one individual corporate golf outing (not a corporate sponsorship) per year at the club up to \$1000 discount or savings. Does not include food or pro shop merchandise.
- The corporation receives a 5% discount on one holiday corporate party per year up to \$500 savings.
- Each corporate designee must be an owner, director, officer, or employee of the Corporation and be approved for membership by the Club.
- Each corporate designee, his or her spouse and dependent children under the age of 23 living at home, will be entitled to all the privileges of a Full Privilege Membership.
- Corporate membership eligible employees drops below 5 (continue to bill for 5). Dues will continue to be billed when membership numbers drop below the minimum.
- New Corporate membership only. Existing Corporate members cannot convert without board approval.
